Every event benefits a charity through the purchase of standard DMC services such as décor, team building, tours and activities--even the airport transportation. You can choose to have the non-profit group be one that is near your headquarters, locally in Southwest Florida or to the charities most important to your organization.

Best of all, there's no carbon footprint. We offset the carbon from CO₂ derived during the program for the transportation services by participating in a tree planting reforestation program. All of the other DMC events and transportation services provided for the group are carbon offset.

At the conclusion of the program, we'll provide documentation of the total offset for services rendered and submit it to the meeting planner and the CSR Director. Even if the company doesn't have a CSR Plan, the documentation will be of interest to the organization's executives and reflect well on the meeting planners efforts and our area.

In addition to our low rates, we provide the following:

For all meeting planners that request a proposal, we will plant a tree as part of a U.S. reforestation project, regardless of whether *Events, Responsibly!* is selected to provide DMC/transportation services for their group.

Should the meeting planner elect to obtain our services, we will ensure the following number of trees are planted at no additional expense as a part of a U.S. reforestation project:
