IMPORTANT! IF YOUR PRODUCTION IS GOING TO USE A UAS/DRONE

Projects using drones/UAS will need to apply for a film permit at least 10 days before photography begins.

THE APPLICANT must first go to: <https://faadronezone.faa.gov/> to complete your paperwork and registration for Part 107. A FAA Approval must be attached to the film permit application before submitting for processing.

- Follow all FAA and Florida State Statutes guidelines (including Statute 934.50)
- Drones are prohibited within 500 feet of any government or municipal buildings
- There is NO DRONE PHOTOGRAPHY ALLOWED in any National, State, County or City Park/Beach
- You must obtain a permit when launching from *any* public property.

Approval of this permit does not exempt the applicant from obtaining applicable permits and complying with applicable regulations from Federal, State, Regional and/or local agencies.

The applicant, in consideration of receiving a Motion Picture & Film Permit from the County, shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Collier County, its officers, agents, and employees from and against all claims, suits, actions, damages, liabilities, expenditures or causes of action of any kind arising out of or occurring during the activities of the applicant from any negligent act, omission or error of the applicant, its agents, servants or employees resulting in or relating to bodies, life, limb or property sustained in, about or upon the permitted premises or improvements thereto, or arising from the use of the premises.
